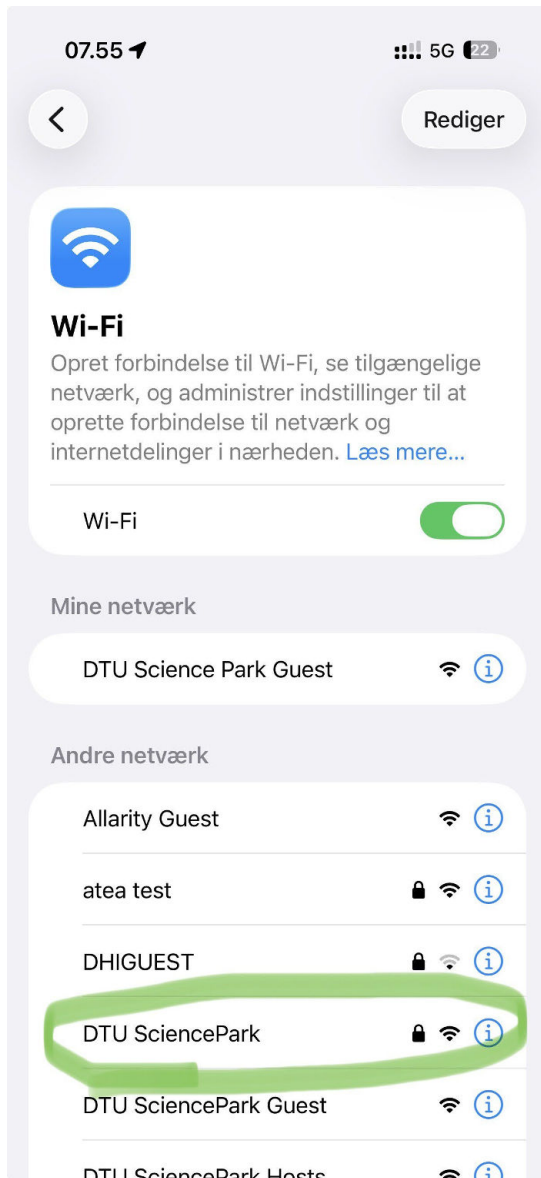


Connect iPhone to Wi-Fi (PEAP)

Step 1: Open Settings → Wi-Fi and select “DTU SciencePark”.

Start connecting to WPA-Enterprise (802.1X).



Step 2: Enter username and password

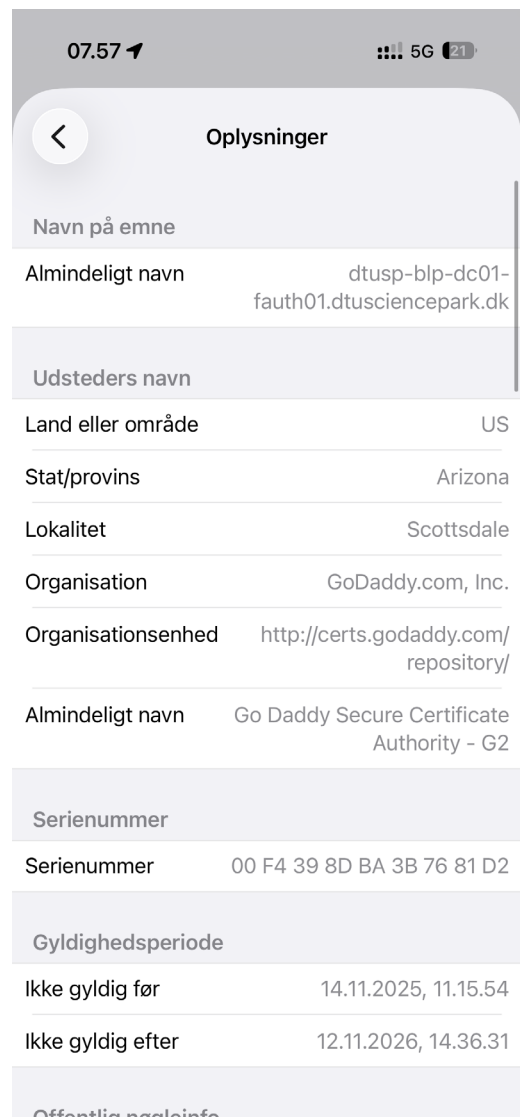
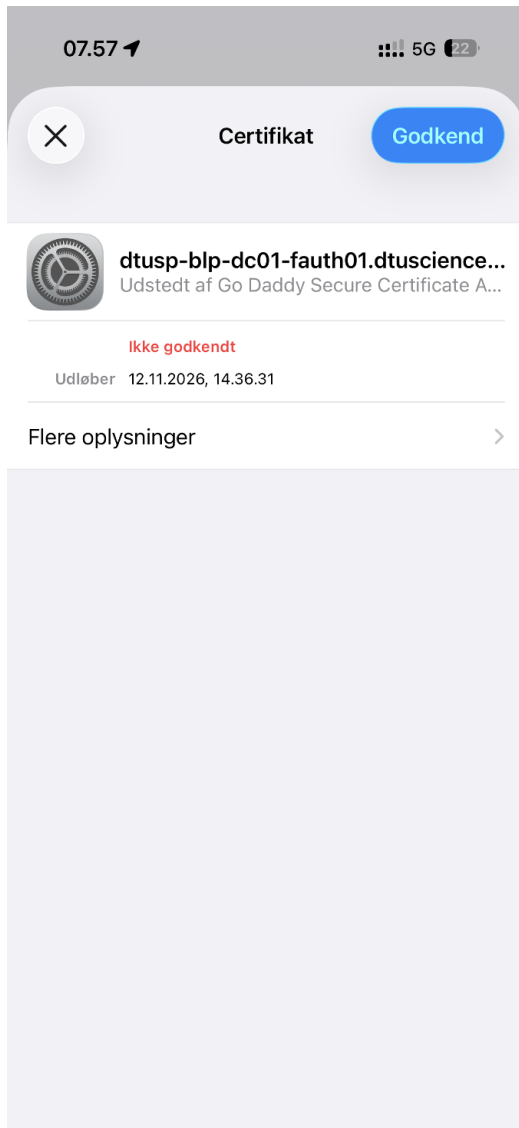
